Program Overview

This program is designed to provide the basic skills needed for entry-level work on a residential or industrial construction site. Participants will develop skills in construction academics, site safety, the use of hand tools and the basics of the construction industry.

Course and Topics Include

Students will learn through a combination of classroom and shop training. Participants will have an opportunity to explore and develop a good understanding of the work involved in several trades such as carpentry, concrete forming, dry walling, and roofing. Students will develop a good understanding of the Saskatchewan Apprenticeship system and the benefits of trade certification.

Industry Requirements

Good eyesight, hearing, manual dexterity, physical agility, and safety conscious. Graduates will have to work at heights and possibly in confined spaces

Academic Requirements

The minimum requirement is Grade 10 with Math 10 and Science 10. (Same to indenture as an apprentice in Carpentry).
