TAKE NOTICE that a Referendum Vote will be held on the 6th day of April, 2010 on Thunderchild Reserve No. 115B to seek the assent of the majority of eligible voters of Thunderchild First Nation to pass legislation of Thunderchild First Nation described as the *Thunderchild First Nation Membership Act, 2010*. For purposes of conducting the within vote, the procedures contained in the *Thunderchild First Nation Constitution* will be followed.

FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that the following questions will be placed before the eligible voters by secret ballot.

As an eligible voter of Thunderchild First Nation having had the opportunity to consider and review the <i>Thunderchild First Nation Membership Act, 2010</i> , are you in favour of such legislation?

FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that the Referendum Officer or a Deputy Referendum Officer(s) designated by the Referendum Officer shall do the following;

1. Prepare a Voters List and a Notice of Referendum and post the Voters List and the Notice of Referendum in a conspicuous place in three main community buildings of Thunderchild First Nation at least thirty (30) days before the voting day;
2. At least thirty (30) days before voting day, a **copy of the Notice of Referendum and a copy of the subject legislation** will be sent by mail to the last known addresses of the eligible voters or hand delivered to such persons;
3. **Voting by mail** is only available to eligible voters who request a Mail-in-Voting package from the Referendum Officer and provide a return mailing address, and such request is received by the Referendum Officer no later than twenty (20) days before the voting day. On receipt of the above request the Referendum Officer sends a Mail-in-Voting Package to the eligible voter at the return address provided. If an eligible voter has voted by mail, the ballot cast in person will be counted and not the mail in ballot.

FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that you may contact Verna Thunderchild; Referendum Officer, or Shirleyann King or Bernard Awasis; Deputy Referendum Officers at (306) 845-4300 to confirm your name is on the Voters List or to obtain a copy of the Notice of Referendum.
