Thunderchild Post Secondary is currently funding 58 students and 3 part time students. One student should be done in January 2010. Another student will be done in February 2010. Another student will be done in March 2010. Approximately there will be 15 graduates by end of July 2010.

There were over 70 applicants for the Winter Term 2010. The postsecondary coordinator is not able to add any additional students for the Winter Term 2010. There were a few students who paid the first semester of school on their own who would be eligible for funding for the Winter Term 2010; however, Thunderchild Postsecondary has already allocated its funding for the whole year. There was a transfer of \$10,000 from Education Advance last week.

At the moment, the postsecondary coordinator is working on the INAC report which is due on December 2, 2009. On this report, the postsecondary coordinator records all the student's information such as Treaty Number, Birth Date, which institute the students are attending, which year the students are in, how many students graduated and how many withdrew.

There was a Postsecondary Coordinator's meeting in Saskatoon on November 17 and 18, 2009, INAC did a presentation about postsecondary funding. Councillors Wilton Angus and Richard Starr attended the meeting along with the postsecondary coordinator.
