- Promote and support traditional cultural teachings and practices for families, community and staff
- Assist in creating and maintaining an environment of safety and wellness in programming
- Implement cultural components in programming i.e. traditional parenting, ceremonies
- Create and present cultural workshops promoting traditional healing, teachings and practices
- Participate in team meetings and agency meetings
- Maintain records, information systems and documentation i.e. contact notes

- Strong indigenous cultural knowledge promoting traditional teachings, wellness and healthy lifestyles
- Some computer knowledge – email, notes and documentation
- Knowledge of child welfare and needs of the community and families
- Knowledge of indigenous language would be an asset
